1. The students registering to FY first time in this academic year 2009-10 shall appear to the courses of REVISED syllabus. The students admitted before the academic year 2009-10 have registered to FY with OLD syllabus. **Accordingly students now shall be labeled as OLD and REVISED.**
2. The students failed in FY BTECH and not eligible to take admission in the SY will reappear for the courses in which they are fail. The re-registration facility can not be availed by such students. The credits earned shall be as per the status of student i.e. OLD or REVISED.
3. **All OLD students having backlog of FY/direct second year students/and those who have not appeared till now for Environmental Studies** shall register to this course of revised curriculum of FY in the summer term. The department of Civil and Water Management shall be responsible for organizing theory lectures of this course in the summer term.
4. The students of OLD curriculum must clear all FY courses before the start of academic year 2011-12. Otherwise they will have to reappear to the courses of new curriculum.

Students failed in the practical component shall reappear as per the OLD curriculum. They scheme of evaluation in the examination will be as specified in the RRs.
