## **Guidelines for Admissions to higher classes and Academics of AY 2021-22**

After discussions in weekly meetings of Deans and HODs, institute prepared the guidelines for admissions to higher classes (only for AY 2021-22) and academics during semester-I of AY 2021-22

## Guidelines to Existing Students of Institute for Admissions to Higher Classes (Only for AY 2021-22)

(Transition from B Tech FY to SY, SY to TY, TY to Final year and M Tech. FY to SY)

- 1. All the UG and PG students registered in AY 2020-21 are promoted to higher classes irrespective of any number backlog subjects.
- 2. The students from SY and TY, of UG with any number of backlog subjects from FY and SY respectively are also promoted to higher classes.
- 3. Students will have to pay fees for the class to which he/she is seeking admission as per Government directives and guidelines.
- 4. For backlog/registration/reregistration, students have to pay the fees as per Institute's rules and regulations.
- 5. Summer examination of AY 2020-21 for FY, SY and TY is cancelled. Students who carry the backlog can appear for the examination in the respective semester where the course is offered. However, the final year students of AY 2020-21, can appear for the Summer Examination-2020-21 with maximum five subjects.

## Guidelines for Academic Activities in the Semester-I of AY 2021-22

(Only for AY 2021-22)

- Students can register for any number of courses from NPTEL/SWAYAM and appear for their examination by paying the requisite fees to NPTEL/ SWAYAM. The marks obtained in these examinations for equivalent courses as suggested in Institute curriculum will be transferred through Institute's grading system.
- 2. For Institute courses, students will have to follow guidelines for online learning and attend the classes, appear for all kinds of evaluations (Continuous assessment, mid-term/end-term) as decided by the institute during Covid-19 pandemic.
- 3. Campus classroom teaching with social distancing norms may be arranged as per the Govt. Guidelines declared from time to time.
- 4. Recorded lectures may be made available to those students who could not attend scheduled online classes.
- 5. The Institute has decided to use e-learning online mode in its teaching-learning process (TLP).
  - a) Theory and Practical classes will be conducted online.
  - b) Facility of Virtual Laboratory will be extended to all the students for conduct of practicals in some of the subjects as per availability.
  - c) Evaluation (Examination) Online/offline/blended (Mixed) mode as per the Institute/ Government guidelines.
  - d) For UG Project/PG Dissertation online Internships are permitted as per industry requirements.

Since the situation is dynamic, we need to adhere to guidelines of lockdown and directives of Govt. of Maharashtra for handling pandemic. The guidelines of Government will supersede the above guidelines (wherever applicable).
