

Evaluation Scheme for Semester-II AY 2020-21


New evaluation scheme for Semester –II of the AY 2020-21 for UG and PG Programs is prepared after the thorough discussions in the weekly meetings of HODs and Deans.

The scheme finalized is as follows:

- ISE1 (In Semester Evaluation before midterm examination): MSE (Mid Semester Evaluation): ISE2 (In Semester Evaluation after midterm examination) : ESE (End Semester Evaluation) with 20% :30%:20%:30% weightages respectively.
- MSE and ESE will be conducted as per the schedule mentioned in Academic Calendar.
- ISE1 and ISE2 evaluations will be flexibly done by teachers with declaration of evaluation schedule at least 8 days in advance.
- ISE may have all possible components of evaluation given in the current RRs of the Institute.
- **All components will be evaluated using online, off-line or blended mode as per convenience of Institute, students and State Government guidelines.**
- Evaluation of practicals will be as per current RRs of the Institute
- This scheme is applicable only for Semester –II of Academic Year 2020-21.
- State Government circulars taken out from time to time may necessitate minor or major changes in the evaluation scheme.

Guidelines for MSE and ESE Theory Examination of Semester-II of AY 2020-21

- The examination will be conducted as per the schedule given in the Academic Calendar of Semester-II for AY 2020-21. The Time-Table of the examination will be shared a week before.
- The modality of this examination will be online proctored environment.
- MSE and ESE examinations will be conducted in MCQ format only.
- Choice for either online (appearing from home) or offline (appearing online within Institute) examinations will be taken by the Department through Google Form.
- To address the queries of students related to examination an Examination Grievance Redressal Cell (EGRC) will be constituted at Department level which will be consisting of HOD, Departmental Examination Coordinator, Dean of Academics and COE. Student should inform to the EGRC of their respective department on email address egrc-XXXX@sggs.ac.in (XXXX- Department Code e.g. EXTC, INST...) within 24 hours from scheduled time of the examination.
- Student has to take the care of internet during the examination period. Re-examination will be conducted in the institute only. The candidate has to remain physically present in the institute and appear for re-examination (if any) from the institute only.
- Every student will get a chance to appear for mock online examination before he/she appears for final examination. The date for mock examination will be communicated soon.
