3. It met group of women and made them aware about pandemic safety measures, hygiene and sanitation, etc.

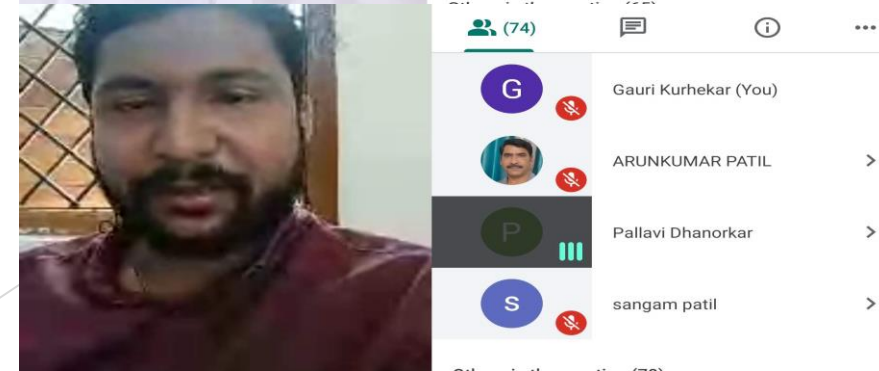


# 5. INTERACTIVE SESSION WITH MPSC RANKERS

Mr. Yogesh Chitte (IRS) also guided the students.



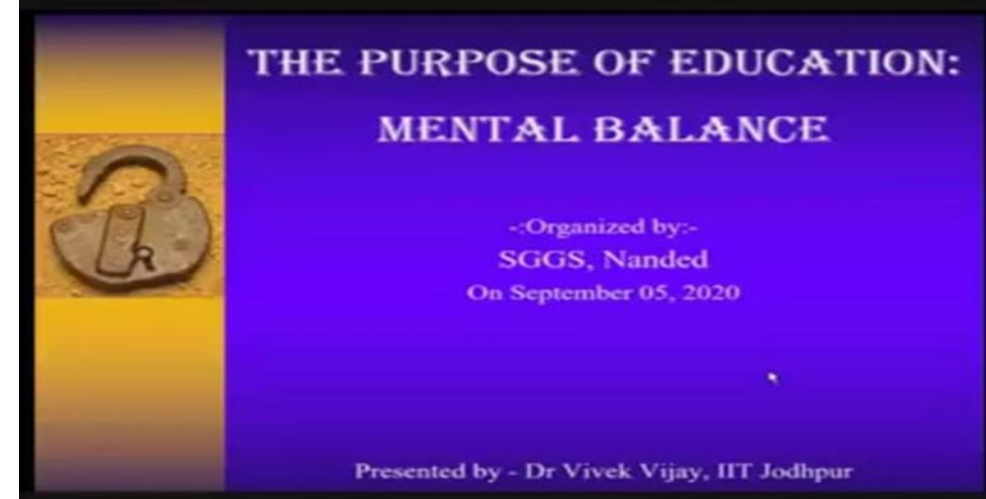


## 6. TEACHER'S DAY LECTURE
