## HOSTEL FACILITIES

## **Background:**

The hostel was started in 1982, after SGGS College was established in 1981 by Govt. of Maharashtra in a Govt. Polytechnic building. Initially, hostel was started in a private Rajasthani Hostel building. Later on with more intake of boys and girls in hostel, more private buildings were hired in nearby areas of Govt. Polytechnic. The college was shifted to its own Vishnupuri Campus in 1987 and then hostel was started in its own building in 1989-90. At present, the institute has two buildings for boys' hostel to accommodate 650 students and three buildings for girls' hostel to accommodate 628 girls. In addition to this, we also provide family accommodation to Ph.D. students admitted under quality Improvement Program (QIP).

#### Infrastructure:

There are five buildings in the hostel campus. Those are named Sahyadri and Nandgiri for boys' hostel, Devgiri, Godawari and Krishna for girls' hostel. There are also QIP quarters.

The hostel houses about 650 boys and 628 girls. The hostel campus houses an office, security-locations, a guest house and Rector/Warden quarters.



#### **Amenities:**

The students are provided with basic amenities like cot, table, chair, cupboard and fan in their rooms. The rooms are spacious, airy and illuminated. Students common rooms/dining halls have TV sets. The 24 hours water supply is provided to all hostels. A generator has been added to ensure supply to messes and common rooms of girls' hostel and boy's hostel.

The hostel campus maintenance like cleaning/sweeping, electrical repairs, plumbing repairs and security services are outsourced. An electrician on campus is available for 24 hours.

## **Dispensary:**

A facility of doctor with a separate dispensary block within the hostel premises is available.

## **Sports:**

The students can also avail the wonderful facility of **play ground** near the hostel. Facilities include cricket (turf, cement and matting wickets), hockey, volley ball, football, basketball and lawn-tennis. A **400 meter running track** with field facilities like jumping and throwing are also available. The tennis court is with floodlight facility allows students to play late in the evening. A separate table-tennis hall is available in the campus.

**The gymnasium** with all modern exercise equipment's are provided for all boys and girls in the campus near their hostel.



## HOSTEL FEE STRUCTURE

(FOR BOYS & GIRLS)

A) Hostel fees (per year) : Rs.22,000/-

B) Hostel Mess Deposit (for new admission): Rs.5,000/-

(Refundable)

C) Hostel Mess Charges : Rs.24,000/-

Students admitted to hostels have to pay total fees as mentioned above at the time of admission only.

## **RULES FOR ADMISSION**

- 1) First year admissions for hostel (for both boys & girls) are branch wise and on merit basis (CET Marks) and as per category reservation.
- 2) From second year to final year, accommodation will be given only for vacant seats and that will be on merit basis (CGPA).
- 3) It is mandatory to pay **full hostel and mess fees** respectively by SBI Collect mode.
- 4) Hostel administration reserves the right to deny admission or cancel admission at any stage.
- 5) Hostel mess is compulsory for every hostel student and everybody should follow all mess rules displayed in mess halls.
- 6) Any type of RAGGING is strictly prohibited. Action as per ragging act will be immediately taken on notice of such act.
- 7) Local Students are not eligible for Hostel Admission.

## HOSTEL RULES AND REGULATIONS

## 1. Ragging is strictly prohibited.

The Maharashtra Legislative Council has passed a bill (LC Bill Number ix of 1999) to prohibit ragging in educational institutions in the State of Maharashtra on 7<sup>th</sup> April 1999. As per this bill -

■ Ragging within or outside of any educational institution is strictly prohibited.



- Whosoever directly or indirectly commits, participates in, abets or propagates ragging within or outside any educational institution shall on conviction, be punished, as per the rules.
- Any student convicted of an offence of ragging shall be dismissed from the educational institution and such student shall not be admitted to any other educational institution for a period of five years from the date of order of such dismissal.

#### 2. Absence from hostel

- Before leaving the hostel, whether to go home or see a local guardian, students should obtain permission from the rector or warden.
- Absence from hostel without permission is liable to heavy fine and punishment.
- The students involved in common-off shall be detained if there is shortage of attendance as prescribed by the rules of institute. Further he/she will be expelled from the hostel.
- 3. Timings for **Boys hostel**: 5.00 am to 09.30 pm Timings for **Girls hostel**: 6.00 am to 07.30 pm Student/s will not be permitted to enter the dorms beyond these hours without the hostel officials' approval.
- **4.** If the student damages any Hostel property (like wash basin, furniture, Electrical equipment, walls etc.), the loss will be recovered from hostel deposit.
- 5. For any absence from the hostel during the night (such as an out-of-town trip), girl students are required to obtain written authorization from the rector or warden. If a girl student violates this regulation, she will be subject to a severe fine the first time and automatic expulsion from the dormitory the second time.



- 6. During stay in hostel campus tobacco consumption (i.e. Ghutka, Pan Masala, smoking etc.) and any alcoholic consumption is strictly prohibited. Any complaint regarding alcohol consumption and nuisance by a concerned student will be considered seriously and the student will be expelled from the hostel, and he/she will have to appear before Institute Disciplinary Committee.
- 7. Students should keep their room neat and clean.
- **8.** Room occupies will ensure that their room is free from pornographic literature, films, CDs, etc. If any of these are found in room, all room occupants will be held responsible.
- 9. No guests are allowed to stay in hostel without prior permission of the Warden/Rector. Guest charge as indicated on the website. If any outsider is found in the room without permission, the students will be held responsible and suchstudents will be expelled from the hostel.
- 10. Once room is allotted to a student, he/she is not allowed to change the room in any circumstances, without prior permission of the Rector/Warden. If found, strict action will be taken.
- 11. Water and electricity should be used economically. Use of electrical appliances e.g. <u>Heater, rod, stove, kettle, iron, hot plate etc.</u> is strictly prohibited. Heavy fine will be charged if the students are found using such appliances and they will be liable for dismissal from the hostel.
- **12.** Students should switch off the light and fan while going out of the room.
- 13. Students should always carry the Hostel Identity Card and produce on demand. Only authentic vehicles are permitted in the hostel premises. The students have to submit the documents of vehicle and stickers will be stuck on such authentic vehicles. Only such vehicles are permitted inside



- the campus. Four Wheeler / Car parking is not allowed for students in Hostel Campus.
- 14. Students of hostel should obey the rules set up by the mess committee to maintain discipline in the mess hall. Mess fees has to be paid in the beginning. Only hostel students are permitted to avail the facility of mess. No guests or outsiders are permitted to take meal in the mess withoutthe prior permission of Rector/ Warden and mess committee, if permitted they have to pay prescribed mess charges.
- 15. The jewellery, cash, laptop, mobile, books, calculator, ornaments, etc. (costly items) should be kept in safe custody, on student's own risk. The authority holds no responsibility for the theft or loss.
- **16.** Do not keep your keys on the door frames etc. or handover to your friends.
- 17. The right to frame new rules, if required, is reserved with the authority to maintain peaceful, secured and a healthy atmosphere in the hostel premises.
- 18. Anyone found disobeying security guard instructions, acting inappropriately in hostel or college grounds, or acting inappropriately on the street, which will harm the reputation of the institution, will be punished and may be permanently expelled from the hostel.
- 19. The decision of the Rector shall be final on the matters pertaining to the hostel.
- **20.** Misuse of internet facility in the hostels will attract severe punishment.
- 21. Any kind of in-disciplinary behavior (e.g. shouting, writing on walls, playing outdoor games in hostel premises, throwing paper etc. through windows. damage of hostel properties) in hostel premises strictly prohibited.

## WARNING

'RAGGING' of students, physically or mentally, is a black spot on the society and is a cognizable offence. The students who have to face ragging can lose their mental stability and can spoil their lives.

All the students are requested not to do such inhuman & cruel act and should give up completely. If any student, is found involved in ragging of juniors or any student, then matter will be handled very seriously. The student may be rusticated and the case may be handed over to the Police. The students should take a serious note of this and act accordingly.



## CIRCULAR

#### No. 101/DTE/CIRCULAR/40753 Dt. 14.12.1993

It had been brought to the notice of the undersigned that in some of the Engineering Colleges and Polytechnics newly admitted students have been subjected to physical and mental torture by senior students in the name of ragging. This has resulted in the ruining the career of the brilliant students and also in the nervous breakdown in some cases.

The Principals of all the Engineering Colleges and Polytechnics are hereby instructed to take a very strict disciplinary action against the students involved in such cases to the extent of removing them from the roll and taking them on books so that this evil does not spread. They are also instructed to take precautionary measures right in the beginning of the session with the help of teaching staff so that such incidents do not take place.

They are further requested to send the report of the steps taken in their institution to the undersigned within a weeks' time.
