Felicitation of freedom fighter

Purpose: Felicitation of freedom fighters under the event Azadi-70 and to acquaints student with their freedom struggle.

Itinerary: Location visited; Kalhali, Taluka-Khandar, Dist-Nanded

Dates of Travel:- 23 August,2016

Key Personnel contacted: Mr. Dattaprakash Naik.

No. of students:79

History of Kalhali:- On 15th August 1947 India became independent but there were some Places which were under the rule of kings and they wanted their freesom and Kalhali comes under one of these Sansthan called Nizam of Rajakar. In 1948, there was drought in Nizam Sansthan but he ordered his officers to collect the Taxes from the people. But in Kalhali, Apparao Naik the Zahagirdar of Kalhai told officer that they are going to pay taxes as there is drought. But the officer Gangadhar Patwari asked police to collect the taxes. In the fight that followed, Apparao Naik fired at police and injured him.

After this incident Nizam sent more police troops from Nanded. On that day Apparao Naik was outside his town and that day the police troops tortured the people and collect the taxes. To take the revenge of this, men of Apparao Naik killed Gangadhar Patwari. This infuriated Nizam and in return he sent 2500-3000 Rajakar and 500-700 Poli8ce officers to kill Apparao Naik.

On the day Apparao Naik and his men all got inside the Gadi(home). On 29th June 3500 troops surrounded this Gadi and for next three days these men fought with the 3500 troops but on the eve of 1st July 1948 these 35 men were killed by police and they become martyr in the history. On 17th September 1948, after approximately 3 months Nizam of Hydreabad Sansthan become part of India.

Observation: Even after 70 year of independence these people have to fight for their development and basic needs. There is no single Martyr Memorial in that village.

Our students have learnt their freedom struggle and gave their opinion about the freedom struggle and what they can do in current scenarios. Before this student only read about the history through the book but on that day, they revive that history and also knew about how freedom fighters have struggled for independence we enjoy today.




