### **Report on Fifth SIC Meeting Held on November 28, 2020**

A Fifth SIC Meeting was conducted on the date November 28, 2020 at 5 PM online with GoogleMeet Platform. The Dean Academics Prof R S Holambe addressed the meeting as a chairperson. Forty Five members were present in the meeting. Former Pragya coordinator and Utsav coordinator were invited for the meeting.

Dr. A. R. Patil, The Dean Students Affairs welcomed all the members and briefly explained the agenda of the meeting.

#### **Agenda of the meeting was:**

1. Online / Offline Pragya and Utsav to be conducted in second semester
2. Examinations and classes related
3. Any problems and suggestions
4. Any other issue

#### **Following are the minutes of the meeting:**

##### **1. Online/Offline Conduct of Pragya and Utsav in next semester**

- Dean Students Affairs Dr. A. R. Patil briefly explained the progress made on formation of New team. Former Pragya Coordinator Mr. Nikhil Prakash Nakod informed us that the procedure of selecting new Pragya Coordinator is finalized and the New Pragya Coordinator is Mr. Shubhum B. Ghoti. Mr. Ghoti informed that he will form his team very soon and will be ready to both types of mode online or offline or both. They will be ready with any kind of mode.
- Prof Holambe discussed the Calendar of next semester and asked members if they are okay with the schedule Pragya, Utsav, Zenith activities which is 5-10 March, 2020. Prof Holambe informed that this will be finalized in HoD meeting of December 02, 2020 and then will send to students for their feedback and at that time these teams can suggest the changes if they want before December 09, 2020 with suggestions from faculty and students.
- Prof Holambe told that Pragya and Utsav coordinators feedback are very important and have to be send those feedback before December 09, 2020.

##### **2. Examinations and Classes related**

- Prof. Holambe explained the pattern of end term examinations. It will be conducted using the same platform and same pattern (MCQ + subjective) with the same vendor-Wheelbox as we did it for Mid term. Most of the questions in End term will be MCQ's.
- Some students had problems in submission but they also informed us that the teacher will take care of that.

- When the Mid term marks will be informed?  
-We assured them to convey this to Hod's in HoD meeting to tell their faculty to show mid term marks at the earliest.
- Can we get answer key of Mid term exam? -  
  
-Prof Holambe told students to ask to your teachers and do not affraid of such questions and demanding these things from your teachers. This is your right. We have requested all Hod's to convey all teachers to download the answer sheets and discuss answers with students. Students can ask to show their marks. The subjective questions have not yet assessed. And we have asked teachers to downlaod answersheets and start asses.
- When the re examination of mid term will be conducted?  
- Prof Holmabe informed us that the date is not finalized and asked students to suggest the convenient dates. Students can also ask to CoE in this case.
- Are there any chances of re-opening of college?  
-Prof Holambe- That can not be decided. Unless we receive clear cut instructions from Govt we can not open. Govt has to tell us.
- T.Y Chemical students had submitted there answer paper online but received message that their exam was not recorded by Wheebox.  
-Prof Holambe and Prof Patil to discuss first with their teachers and then talk to CoE. We also ensured to talk to CoE in this regard. CoE will help in this regard.
- Students also informed that there were lot of messages popining up at the time of writing of exams.  
-To this prof Holambe answered not to worry if you have not done any unethical and we can find out who did the wrong things.

### 3. **Any Problems and Suggestions**

There was no problem and no issue as such except the mid term end term questions which were discussed.

### 4. **Any Other Issue**

- New Pragya Coordinator Mr Ghoti requested all the faculty members and students to give their valubale suggestions on conducting online Pragya as well as Utsav and Zenith activities. This will help them in organizing these events effectively. In any case we have planned to go ahead to organize these events.
- Students can discuss among themselves and in next meeting they can present their ideas for online conduct of P-U-Z events.
